How to get to Vilnius:

PLANE:

Vilnius airport is located on the outskirts of Vilnius city (<u>http://www.vilnius-airport.lt/en/)</u> From the airport to the city: public bus No 2 to Vilnius city centre and No 1 to the Railway and Bus station (<u>http://www.vilniustransport.lt/lt/</u>). It takes about 20 min to get to the city centre. Taxi operates. Be careful, the company operating at the airport charges double-triple prices compared to other taxi companies.


Institute of Botany of the Nature Research Centre (Verkiai palace) Zaliuju Ezeru str. 49 LT-08406 Vilnius, Lithuania

How to get to the workshop venue:



The most comfortable way of transport is TAXI - the price from downtown to the workshop place is ca 5-7 EUR (1.25 Litas per 1 km + 2.00 Lt call charge). 1 Euro=3.45 Lt. Public transport: (NRC/GTC) – workshop venue is accessible by busses No 35, 36, 76 (Bus stop "Verkiu rumai" / "Verkiai palace"). The Institute of Botany of the Nature Research Centre is located in the northern part of the city (see red dot). Blue lines = busses, red lines = trolleybuses. Distance from the bus / railway station to the workshop venue is 8.7 km (pink line).



Travel recommendations – how to get from the city to the Verkiai palace:


Take bus No 05 (private bus company; tickets onboard only; not to mix up with the minicipal bus No 5 and trolley-bus No 5) or municipal bus No 26 and ride to the "Naujakiemio" bus stop. Step off. Wait for bus 35 or 36 and ride to "Verkiu rumai". Recommended time table is shown bellow. Traveling takes 40-45 min. Add 10 min. for strolling to the Institute of Botany across the Verkiai Park.

If you live in the central part of the city there is a number of buses and trolleybuses driving to the "Naujakiemio" bus stop where you change for No 35 or 36.


Bus tickets for municipal transport cost 2.00 Lt when purchased at the kiosk in advance and 2.50 Lt when purchased in the bus. They are valid for single bus boarding and are not time limited. If you change the bus, you need a new ticket.
