



Main outcomes of 2011 CO₂GeoNet/CGS Europe Open Forum

- Good overview of: demos, pilots, natural / experimental field sites, latest research results
- → Several issues raised, e.g.
 - → Terminology: storage complex, leakage ...
 - → Different uses of the subsurface: priorities, conflicts of use?
 - Knowledge-sharing, information, communication
 - Create trusty environments for taking on board all views and finding solutions together
 - → What if a leakage occur (b-out groups practical exercice)
 - → Public acceptance at local level
 - Urgency, make faster progress
 - → Costs
 - → Regulations
